STATEMENT OF CONCERN

It has been my honor and pleasure to serve as a member of the Amigos Board of Directors for the past three years, and to serve as Chair of the Board this year. The experience of working with the leadership of Amigos and all of the members of the Board has been incredibly rewarding. I am continually gratified by the dedication of the Amigos staff in serving the needs of your member libraries.

Since joining the Board in 2009, I have witnessed firsthand the significant changes that have occurred within Amigos as the organization has adapted to the current economic and technological environments within which member libraries are operating. Very significant changes have also occurred in Amigos' business and contractual relationships with OCLC.
